PSP What

- 2010 FMCSA Initiative
 - Went Live May 2010
- Provides motorcoach employers and industry service providers with crash and inspection information on potential new hires
- Voluntary for employers, industry service providers, and drivers
- Driver must provide written consent

PSP Why

- Required by SAFETEA-LU
- Increase safety
- Assist companies in making better informed decisions on new hires
- Improves data quality
 - Can request a review of the data through FMCSA's DataQs System https://dataqs.fmcsa.dot.gov/login.asp

PSP Data

- Motor Carrier Management Information System (MCMIS)
 - 5 years crash data
 - 3 years inspection data
- Does not include conviction data
- Same as FMCSA's Driver Information Resource (DIR)
- Different from an MVR

PSP vs. MVR

- PSP report contains a driver's crash and roadside inspection history
- MVR contains a driver's convictions from a state
- MVR is only activity associated with a single state CDL
- View PSP data for all CDLs a driver has held in the past 5 years
- MVR timeframe varies by state

PSP How

- Secure electronic, web-based system or mobile iPhone app
- Instant access for drivers and enrolled account holders
- Fee for account holder service, single monthly invoice
- Provided by NIC Technologies
 - Partners with FMCSA for development, hosting, management, education, and customer service

Account Holder Enrollment

- Submit PSP enrollment agreement
 - Customer service team reviews agreement
 - Users receive individual login credentials
- Users must agree to all legal and usage constraints and warnings
- PSP customer service helps with ongoing account management

PSP for Drivers

- YES, and FMCSA encourages them to do so!
- No enrollment required
- Driver can share their own PSP record or motorcoach operator can obtain through PSP system
- Also available via Privacy Act / Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) from FMCSA

Data Protection

- Data handling must adhere to:
 - Privacy Act
 - Fair Credit Reporting Act
 - All Other Applicable Federal Laws
- NIC Technologies cannot change data
- Driver identity verification

Driver Consent Audit

- Ensure account holders are capturing driver consent
- Increase awareness of driver consent process
- Ensure that drivers are aware their reports are being accessed

Audit Procedures

- PSP account holders are selected
- Account holders receive email notification upon selection
- Up to 3 specific PSP requests will be audited
- Account holders must provide proof of drivers' consent form (paper or electronic consent accepted)

Audit Requirements

- All account holders must use the FMCSA-provided consent language
- Consent must include driver name and signature (hand-written or electronic)
- Consent must include the date
- Consent date must be on or prior to the day the account holder requested the driver's PSP record

Submitting Audit Information

- Consent forms may be uploaded into the PSP system or emailed to PSPaudit@egov.com
- Account holders receive confirmation email after the audit document(s) are received

Audit Penalties

- Account holders who do not comply with audits are subject to penalties
- Penalties severities vary and include warnings, suspensions, and terminations
- Penalty severity increases with multiple audit failures
- Account holders return to "good standing" after 12 months of acceptable audit activity

Carriers with fewer than 100 power units qualify for a discounted annual fee of \$25 per year.

Individuals can request a personal driving history for a fee of \$10. No subscription is necessary for individual drivers.
